Decision 4: Which is the most certain of all the basic things that faith tells us?

**To the left** Love is the way

**In the center** We were made for heaven

**To the right** Everything that happens follows God's plan

Decision 5: People live very different kinds of lives. At the end of their lives:

**To the left** Some will face the consequences of their choices and they will have to pay

**To the right** All will share fully in all that God will give to our entire human family

Decision 6: Since we are going to share God's life as a family, we are called to be a family, a family of faith here on earth. Perhaps it seems obvious, but what concretely does it mean?

**To the left** God wants all of us to belong to same actual institution

**To the right** The most important thing is that we get together with others to share our faith

Decision 7: It's time to talk about Jesus. Jesus primary mission was:

**To the left** To found the Church

**To the right** To die for our sins

Decision 8: The Resurrection identified Jesus as God's Son, he whom God wants us to follow. Thus, the best way to speak about the resurrection is:

**To the left** The Resurrection is a conclusion of Christian faith

**To the right** The Resurrection is a proof of Christian faith
